The Rossi Bar is on Queens Road, the road from Brighton Station to



the seafront.

This photograph looks back up past The Rossi Bar on the left to the station, you can park outside the venue to unload, but will need to leave your car elsewhere.

Parking in central Brighton car parks is expensive and there is little on street parking.

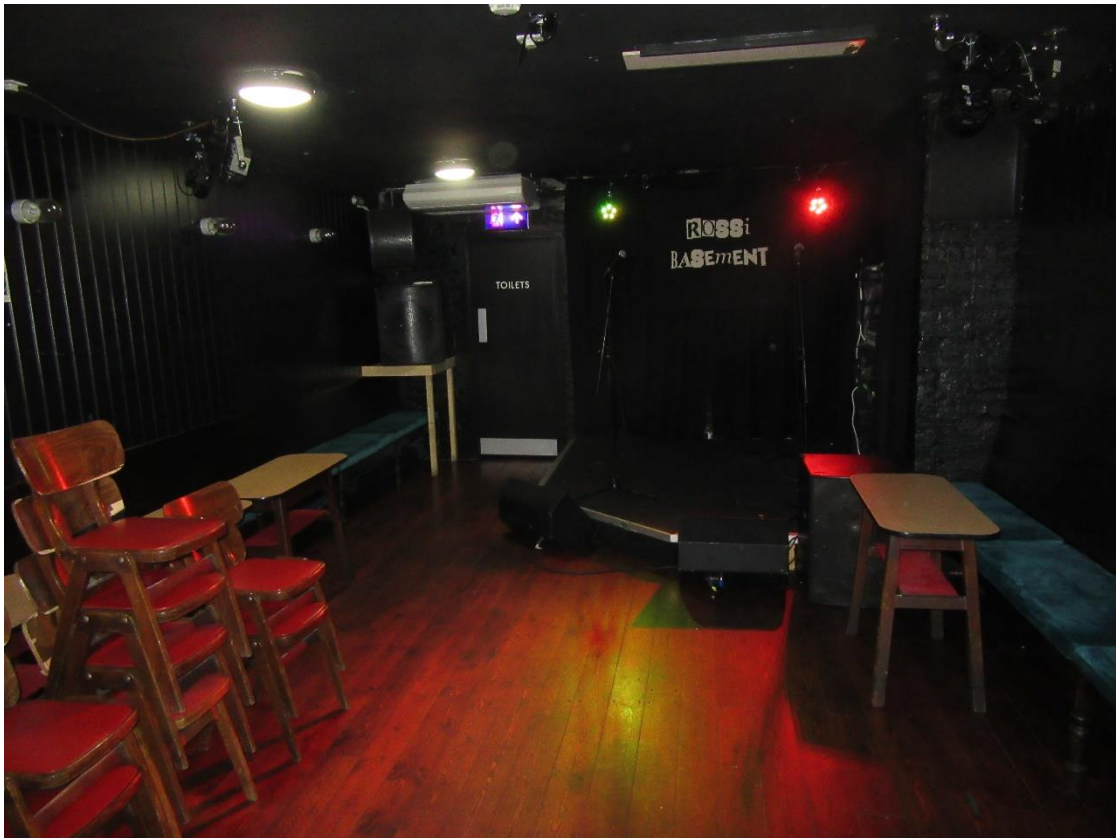


The Rossi Bar can be hard to spot as the pavement is very narrow. We usually have a poster outside. But not always.



The venue itself is down the circular stairs on the left as soon as you go in. We start letting people in from 8pm

The first act will usually be on stage at 8:30, and sets are 30 minutes long.



The room itself is small with a stage at the far end.



We usually have earplugs, hand sanitiser and facemasks on the table at the door.

These are the people you may meet on the night.
