the seafront.




This photograph looks back up past The Rossi Bar to the station, you can park outside the venue to unload, but will need to leave your car elsewhere. Parking in central

Brighton car parks is expensive and there is little on street parking.




The Rossi Bar can be hard to spot as the pavement is very narrow. We usually have a poster outside. But not always.



The venue is down the circular stairs on the left as soon as you go in, its often blocked by some bar stools to stop people from coming in, but just come straight past.

Usually we get there for 6, but if you are in town earlier and want to drop something off, the bar staff will usually let you do that from about 5.




The room itself is small with a stage at the far end.



If you need a table, there are tables in the venue, but they are small, and quite low, if you need something bigger and cannot bring your own or let us know and we will bring something along for you.

But these seem to work well for most people we put on.



The mixer is pretty basic: XLRs for Microphones etc, otherwise mono ¼" Jack Plugs (also known as guitar leads).

There aren't many channels, so if you have a lot of outputs it would be a good idea to bring a submixer to have onstage so you can control your levels.



The PA is pretty good, it's loud with plenty of bass and some monitors.



We take our own screen down for visuals, if you want to have your own visuals projected, please let us know in

advance and we can arrange for you to send the files to Chris in advance and he will show them for you, otherwise he makes his own.
